Financial information in this report represents Operating Fund figures, and may not reflect all assets or expenses of a library. Libraries are not required to report to the State on endowment or other assets or funds originating with non-tax dollars, unless these dollars pass through the operating fund.

All 2024 figures come from the State Annual Reports. The first 8 pages and pages 36-43 use 2025 figures, rather than 2024.
